

A STATEMENT FROM REED EXHIBITIONS – ORGANIZERS OF INFOSECURITY MEXICO

July 15th, 2020

Reed Exhibitions Mexico, organizer of **Infosecurity Mexico**, today announced that the 2020 face-to-face event, scheduled for September 22 and 23 at Centro Citibanamex, **has been postponed to May 26 and 27, 2021**, following the continuing international travel restrictions and the restrictions that the local government has in place for public events.

Infosecurity Mexico is an interactive event that offers a high-level educational program, networking and profitable business opportunities for the cybersecurity and IT community.

Commenting on the announcement, Juan Manuel Rodriguez, Show Director, stated, "Given the current situation, we have made the difficult decision to postpone Infosecurity Mexico until May 2021, thus safeguarding the health and wellbeing for everyone involved.

After a comprehensive analysis, we concluded that the current conditions do not allow us to guarantee the quality of the event in September, but we are attentive to the evolution of the situation, rigorously abiding by the recommendations of both federal and local health authorities. In parallel, at Reed Exhibitions we have developed a 5-Point Plan with measures that will allow us to safeguard the health and safety of all those who participate in our event in 2021".

In addition, Rodriguez stressed, "We are working hard to offer virtual solutions to satisfy the needs of the cybersecurity community. Our Online Infosecurity Summit will be an intensive 3-day training program focused on risk mitigation and security breaches due to hyper connectivity; timely detection of threats, and, information security strategies taking into account human risks".

"On behalf of Reed Exhibitions, I would like to express my gratitude to all our exhibitors, partners, attendees, suppliers, media, and staff for their support. Infosecurity Mexico will continue to be the quality event that the industry expects, next year." Rodriguez concluded.
